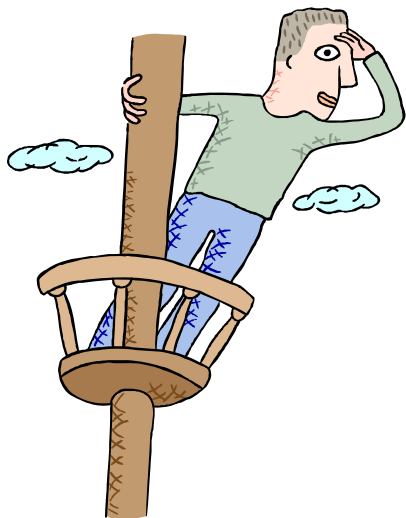


Summer Service Camp 2006

Parents and participants will kick off the week by joining in Sunday worship at one of the churches in Chester.
